**Financial Needs Statement:** Be specific about your financial needs, explaining how this scholarship will make a significant difference in your academic life. Please include copies of your parents' and your (if applicable) W-2 forms for the year 2010.

**Letters of Recommendation:** Please include two recent letters of recommendation from people familiar with your abilities in your selected performance area.

**A full-length photo or headshot** (*optional*)

### SCHOLARSHIP OVERVIEW

**Scholarship Amount:** Constance T. Rockwell Performing Arts Scholarships are awarded in a minimum amount of \$4,000. Scholarships must be applied towards tuition for the student's freshman year at an accredited college, university, or conservatory that offers a four-year program in theater or performing arts, e.g. dance, drama, music, voice, costume design, set design, lighting, or sound.

**Eligibility:** Scholarships are limited to high school seniors. Teachers are not eligible for scholarships. Student must have applied to an accredited college, university or conservatory that offers a four-year program with a requisite audition. If a student receives a full scholarship from any other source, he or she will not be eligible for the Constance T. Rockwell Scholarship. However, those receiving a partial scholarship or scholarships are eligible.

**Criteria for Determination of Semi-Finalists:** Applicants will be evaluated with regard to financial need, experience, and scholastic merit, as well as school and community involvement. All applicants will receive notification of their status after the committee has thoroughly reviewed all applications.

**Audition Criteria:** Each semi-finalist will be invited to audition for the scholarship committee. Auditioning students will be judged based on talent, professional presence, and interpersonal skills. Finalists will be contacted shortly after the audition.

*It is the intent that the Constance T. Rockwell Performing Arts Scholarship program will continue; however, the Civic Light Opera Guild reserves the right to modify or discontinue the program at any time. The amount and number of scholarships awarded will be determined by the scholarship committee. Scholarships are for tuition only and checks will be made payable to the school specified by the student. All applicants are otherwise eligible without regard to race, color, religion, gender, or national origin.*
